History of March 18

- ♦ 1944 : Azad Hind Fauj of Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose crossed the border of Burma.
- ◆ 1910: He presented his proposal to Gopal Krishna Gokhale for the provision of compulsory and free primary education.
- 1922: A British court sentenced Mahatma Gandhi to six years in a sedition case after the Civil Disobedience Movement.
- ♦ 1956: Narayan Shastri Marathe, famous Marathi scholar, passed away

Current Affairs Related to 18 March

- According to IT services provider Tech Mahindra, former Infosys chairman Mohit Joshi has been appointed as the managing director and chief executive officer of the company for a five-year term beginning December 20, 2023, ending on December 19, 2028. Mohit Joshi will replace Gurnani, one of the longest serving CEOs in the Indian IT industry.
- ♦ Siddhartha Mohanty has been elected as the interim chairman of Life Insurance Company of India for a period of 3 months. Currently the Managing Director and CEO of LIC Housing Finance, Mohanty will take over as the MD of Life Insurance Corporation on February 1, 2021. Siddhartha Mohanty was proposed to lead as MD of LIC, till his superannuation on 30 June 2023. The current MDs of LIC are Bishnu Charan Patnaik, IPE Mini, Siddharth Mohanty and Raj Kumar while the chairman of the company is Mr. Mangalam Ramasubramanian Kumar.
- India's struggle for independence continued in the Gandhian era. Supreme Court Judge Justice V. Ramasubramanian has released a book titled Gandhian Era of India's Struggle for Independence. The book, written by former Madras High Court judge P. Jyothimani and former Pachaiyappa College history professor G. Balan and published by Vanathi Pathipagam, was released at an event organized at the University of Madras. The book covers aspects such as the relevance of Mahatma Gandhi.
- The first Supreme Audit Institution meeting of 20 senior officials was held in Guwahati. This meeting is part of the G20 summit. It started with the theme Blue Economy and Responsible Artificial Intelligence. Supreme Audit Institution 20 aims to bring together an ecosystem in which Supreme Audit Institutions are active participants in governance. Comptroller and Auditor General of India Girish Chandra Murmu presided over the meeting.

- Knight Frank, a global real estate consultancy, released its Health Report 2023, which provides insights into the trends and performance of key residential property markets around the world. Among Indian respondents, the advisor said that UHNWI wealth is expected to increase by 88 percent in 2022. Going forward, Indian respondents expect the wealth of the ultra wealthy to continue to rise in 2023.
- Oscar Awards 2023: The 95th Academy Awards have announced that RRR's Naatu Naatu has won the Best Original Song. The song had to beat songs like Tell It Like a Woman's Applause, Top Gun: Forever's Lift Me Up and Yeh Jeevan Hai. The Oscar was accepted by lyricist Chandra Bose and music composer Keeravani. The lyrics of the song were penned by Chandrabose, with music by MM Keeravani and it was performed by Kaal Bhairav & Rahul Sipliganj.
- Kochi Metro has become the first Metro to accept digital currency in its parking facilities. IDFC First Bank has partnered with Anantham Online to enable acceptance of digital money at parking facilities of Kochi Metro. Anantham Online is a technology startup focused on digital parking. With the help of this initiative, users of Kochi Metro will be able to make payments from CBDC wallets of their respective banks. The CBDC is currently in the first phase of implementation with four banks. IDFC First Bank is one of them.
- The International Golden City Gate Tourism Awards 2023 in the categories of TV/Cinema Commercials International and Country International were won by the Indian Ministry of Tourism and Government of India respectively. The award has been given to promotional films/television commercials created by the Ministry as part of a global effort on advertising in the post-Covid period to re-open opportunities in India. The award was accepted by Shri Arvind Singh, Secretary Government of India at ITB, Berlin.
