## History of March 22

- ◆ 1739: The invader Nadir Shah allowed his army to massacre in Delhi.
- ♦ **1882**: The deadly infectious disease TB was identified.
- ♦ 1888 : The English Football League was established.
- ♦ 1942 : Britain signed a treaty to liberate Jordan.
- ◆ 1977: Mrs. Indira Gandhi resigned from the post of Prime Minister.
- ♦ 1978 : France conducted a nuclear test.

### **Current Affairs Related to 22 March**

- A new announcement has been made by the government regarding the Gaganyaan mission. Accordingly, the first abort mission of Gaganyaan will be launched in May. It is the first of four aborted missions for India's manned space mission using test vehicles or test rockets. Under this, the first test vehicle mission TV-D1 is scheduled in May 2023. This will be followed by the second test vehicle TVD2 mission in the first quarter of 2024, which is the first unmanned mission of Gaganyaan.
- The Bar Council of India has taken a major decision regarding the legal profession in the country. Under the decision, BCI has allowed foreign lawyers and law firms to practice in India for the first time. For this, the apex body of lawyers, BCI has notified the Rules for Registration and Regulation for Foreign Lenders and Foreign Law Firms in India 2022. This decision will be confirmed with some restrictions.
- The spacesuit has features to help astronauts conduct scientific experiments on the lunar surface. Spacesuits would be a better fit for female astronauts. According to NASA, the suit should be ready for the Artemis III mission to the Moon in 2025. NASA had earlier promised to send the first woman to the lunar surface. Earlier plans to send female astronauts into space had failed due to the lack of spacesuits of their size.
- RBI Governor Shaktikanta Das has been given the Governor of the Year award at the Central Banking Awards 2023. The award has been given to Shaktikanta Das because he steered the financial markets through several crises. These crises include inflation and epidemics caused by the war in Ukraine. Former Gunner Raghuram Rajan was the first Indian to receive the award in 2015. Das is currently in his second term as the RBI governor.He is the 25th Governor of RBI. He was appointed as the RBI governor in December 2018.

- Banking partnership Indian Premier League team
  Royal Challengers Bangalore has signed Equitas
  Small Finance Bank as its banking partner for the
  IPL 2023 season. This partnership means that Equitas
  Small Finance Bank will provide Royal Challengers
  with a range of banking services such as salary accounts, foreign exchange and other related financial services.
- According to a published study, 58 percent of people in 31 countries are facing freshwater shortage. The report is published ahead of the United Nations 2023 Water Conference to be held in New York on March 22-24, 2023. The objective of the conference is to raise awareness, define the roadmap and advance the water agenda.
- The US, Australia and Britain have announced a deal to provide Australia with nuclear attack submarines. This decision is an important step towards countering the growing activities of China in the Indian Pacific region. US President Joe Biden, Australian Prime Minister Anthony Albanese and UK Prime Minister Rishi Sunak announced the AUCS project agreement at the US Naval Base in San Diego, California.
- Denmark has launched a project to store carbon dioxide under 1800 meters of the North Sea. It will become the first country in the world to store carbon dioxide imported from abroad. Project Greensand is being led by German oil major Wintersall DEA and British chemical firm Ineos. The project will store eight million tonnes of carbon dioxide annually by 2030. The project has 23 Danish and international partners.
- The US recognized the McMahon Line as the international boundary between India and China. The McMahon Line was recognized by the United States as the international boundary between India's Arunachal Pradesh and China.
