- ♦ 1931: The great revolutionaries Bhagat Singh,
  Rajguru and Sukhdev were hanged.
- ◆ 1986: The first women's company was trained in the Central Reserve Police Force.
- ♦ 1950: The United Nations World Meteorological De-

partment was established.

- ◆ 1940 : The All India Muslim League demanded a separate country for Muslims.

#### **Current Affairs Related to 23 March**

- ♦ Union Railway Minister Ashwini Vaishnav said in a written reply in the Lok Sabha that the Indian Railways has set a target of becoming a net zero carbon emitter by 2030. Railways is planning to achieve this ambitious target in two phases. Full transition to electric trains by December 2023 and powering trains and stations mainly through non-renewable sources by 2030. Railway Minister Ashwini Vaishnav has set a target for Indian Railways to become a net zero carbon emitter by 2030.Railway Minister said that the energy requirement of Railways is expected to be around 8200 MW in 2029-30.
- ◆ IDFC First Bank an Indian private sector bank has become the official banking partner of Mumbai Indians, the franchise cricket team participating in the Indian Premier League. As the Official Banking Partner, IDFC First Bank will provide Mumbai Indians and its players with various financial products and services including banking solutions, credit cards and digital banking services.
- Despite the government's efforts to promote sanitation and eliminate open defecation in India, recent surveys have cast doubt on the success of these initiatives. Some of the four government surveys released from 2018 to 2021 have refuted the claim that all Indian villages are free of open defecation.
- The Bureau of Indian Standards has launched the Learning Science via Standards initiative to promote science learning among school students. The objective of the program is to improve student learning outcomes in science and foster interest in science education by providing them access to national and international standards related to science. The initiative is part of BIS's efforts to improve the quality of education in India and supports the government's efforts to make India a global leader in science and technology. Learning Science Via Standards initiative for students which focuses on providing lesson plans related to products used in daily life.

- Viacom18 has appointed MS Dhoni as its brand ambassador to encourage digital sports viewing. Dhoni in association with Viacom18 will encourage fans to watch their favorite sports on digital platforms. He will participate in various network initiatives and feature in the upcoming Tata IPL campaign for JioCinema, as well as promote the brand on his social media accounts.MS Dhoni has partnered with Viacom18 to promote the digital platform with an aim to make it the ultimate access point for sports fans.
- ♦ Domestic rating agency CRISIL believes that the country's economy will grow at a rate of 6 percent in the financial year 2023-2024. According to the agency, the country's economy will grow at an average rate of 6.8 percent for the next five years. This estimate of CRISIL is similar to other estimates made about the growth of the economy. The agency believes that there could be double digit growth in the earnings of companies in the next financial year.
- Assam Finance Minister Ajanta Neog presented a deficit budget of Rs 935.23 crore with an outlay of Rs 1,39,755 crore in the Assembly. Government announced that 40,000 candidates will be recruited for government jobs till 10th May and another 18,000 will be recruited soon.
- ♦ Delhi's Indira Gandhi International Airport has been adjudged the best in India and South Asia for the fifth time in a row. Sky Trax has given this airport a 4 star rating. It has also been included in the list of top airports around the world since 2020. The overall ranking has also improved to 36th position. Last year it was ranked 37th.
- ♦ Delhi has got the fourth place in the list of 50 most polluted cities of the world. Delhi ranks fourth in terms of PM 2.5 levels in 2022, according to IQAir's World Air Quality Report.
