History of March 26

- ♦ 1552 : Guru Amardas became the third Guru of the Sikhs.
- ♦ 1668 : England took over Bombay.

- 1973: Farmers in the Indian state of Uttarakhand launched an environmental protection movement called the Chipko movement to protest the felling of trees.

Current Affairs Related to 26 March

- Income Tax Department launched AIS App for taxpayers. AIS App will help the taxpayers to view their Annual Information Statement. This app will provide taxpayers with detailed information about each and every transaction. Taxpayers can also give feedback on the displayed AIS information through this app. It will also promote voluntary compliance and enable seamless prefilling of returns. Annual information statements can be assessed through mobile application and web portal.
- The Executive Board of the IMF has approved Sri Lanka's bailout program under the Extended Fund Facility. 2.286 billion special drawing rights package will be available in 4 years. This would equate to approximately \$3 billion. The decision of the Executive Board will allow immediate disbursement of \$333 million. This is Sri Lanka's 17th credit program with the IMF. Sri Lanka is going through its worst economic crisis since its independence in 1948.
- Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina inaugurated Bangladesh's first submarine base BNS Sheikh Hasina at Pekua in Cox's Bazar. It is an ultra modern submarine base. The newly commissioned submarine base will enhance the operational capability of the Bangladesh Navy to secure vast maritime resources. Sheikh Hasina said that ships passing through the Bay of Bengal can seek help from the base. Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina said that the government is working on the goal of transforming its military force into a modern organization.
- Finland has installed the world's first sand battery. These batteries are capable of storing heat from renewable energy sources for months. A sand battery is a high temperature thermal energy storage device that uses sand or a sand-like material. It stores energy in the sand in the form of heat This is a battery made of sand collected from construction sites, which can solve the problem of year-round energy supply.

- Indian Space Research Organisation's launch vehicle Mark III is ready for launch of OneWeb India2 mission. The mission will be launched on March
 26 from the Satish Dhawan Space Center in
 Sriharikota, Andhra Pradesh. This will be the rocket's
 sixth mission overall and second commercial mission. It is a dedicated commercial mission through
 NewSpace India Limited, the commercial arm of
 ISRO.
- The B20 conference held in Gangtok, Sikkim under India's G20 chairmanship focused on exploring business opportunities in tourism, hospitality, pharmaceuticals and organic farming. The event brought together delegations from 22 countries and over 100 Indian delegations to showcase Sikkim's potential in these fields. This meet will provide a unique opportunity to promote startups in North East India.
- ♦ Rohan Bopana, a 43-year-old Indian tennis player and his Australian partner Matthew Ebden have become the oldest duo to win the ATP Masters 1000 title. They defeated top seeds Wesley Koolhoff and Neil Skupski to win the men's doubles final at the Indian Wells Masters 2023 tournament in California.
- Sampanna Ramesh Shelar, a graduate student in Physical Education, has set a new record by becoming the fastest Indian to swim across the Palk Strait from Talaimannar in Sri Lanka to Dhanushkodi in Tamil Nadu in the under-21 category. He covered the distance of 29 km in just 5 hours 30 minutes breaking the previous record of 8 hours 26 minutes.
- G Krishnakumar has been appointed as the Chairman and Managing Director of BPCL. G Krishnakumar is working in BPCL since last 36 years. He was instrumental in revolutionizing the downstream fuel retail industry in the country. Vetsa Ramakrishna Gupta is holding the additional charge of CMD. He also holds the additional charge of Director.




